I have been designing and making furniture for over twenty years and my work ranges from domestic commissions to work for public bodies and organisations including churches, museums and galleries and outdoor and public spaces. My work uses high quality materials, exhibits a high level of craft skill and attempts to offer interesting and relevant solutions.

I have wide experience of working with others and communicating my ideas developed through writing, teaching and collaborating with other artists and professionals, clients and user groups. Working in the public realm I am used to dealing with complex situations and am able to deliver high specification work in response to tight budgets and timetables.

I have a deep interest (furthered through a research MA) in the way people use public space and the objects within it. My ideas, expressed in my recent work, centre around offering opportunities for activities and attempting to provide an environment that is physically and culturally diverse. This work is designed for the particular place for which it is intended and I see this place, its physical and social characteristics and the aspirations of the various communities it serves as the starting point for my design ideas.
